in catastrophic success alexander b downes compiles all instances of regime change around the world over the past two centuries drawing on this impressive data set downes shows that regime change increases the likelihood of civil war and violent leader removal in target states and fails to reduce the probability of conflict between intervening states and their targets as downes demonstrates when a state confronts an obstinate or dangerous adversary the lure of toppling its government and establishing a friendly administration is strong the historical record however shows that foreign imposed regime change is in the long term neither cheap easy nor consistently successful the strategic impulse to forcibly oust antagonistic or non compliant regimes overlooks two key facts first the act of overthrowing a foreign government sometimes causes its military to disintegrate sending thousands of armed men into the countryside where they often wage an insurgency against the intervener second externally imposed leaders face a domestic audience in addition to an external one and the two typically want different things these divergent preferences place imposed leaders in a quandary taking actions that please one invariably alienates the other regime change thus drives a wedge between external patrons and their domestic protégés or between protégés and their people catastrophic success provides sober counsel for leaders and diplomats regime change may appear an expeditious solution but states are usually better off relying on other tools of influence such as diplomacy regime change downes urges should be reserved for exceptional cases interveners must recognize that absent a rare set of promising preconditions regime change often instigates a new period of uncertainty and conflict that impedes their interests from being realized

in this book jacqueline jiménez polanco examines the politics of empowerment of dominican americans in the united states covering the first two decades of the twenty first century jiménez polanco provides a new analytical perspective to understand the political development of a growing ethnic community that has been historically neglected in the studies of latino a x political development and whose peculiar characteristics represent a paradigmatic case that debunks pervading theories about immigrant communities participation and representation in u s electoral politics rich archival research and interviews with key dominican american leaders and activists shed light on how some patterns followed by dominican americans in their political empowerment correspond to those of other latino a x communities while other patterns distinctly diverge from that common trend dominican american politics immigrants activists and politicians serves as a perfect companion for courses on latino a x and dominican studies and u s ethnic politics

when china and russia established a strategic partnership in 1996 both nations declared that they would further develop military cooperation in various fields tsai examines the course of this military cooperation to reveal the nature of the military ties with the hopes of determining whether these two traditional adversaries have put aside historical legacies and mutual mistrust to create a full fledged military partnership after analyzing the motives and concerns of both powers tsai concludes that while progress has been made in reducing military tensions in border regions the level of trust has not increased substantially the nature of these ties remains extremely fragile among western analysts there has been concern that a closer partnership might adversely affect u s interests in the region china and russia have developed cooperation in certain areas such as arms transfers and military technical cooperation and these achievements have successfully reduced political tension however reciprocal threats against each other s territories and china s increasing ambitions and capacity to act as a great military power in the region could eventually become a major source of friction based on research in both chinese and russian this study offers a comprehensive analysis on the development of and limits to this military cooperation

the way the money goes traces out what happened to the uk s fiscal constitution the framework for planning and controlling public spending under three different governments conservative labour conservative liberal democrat from the early 1990s to the mid 2010s the book tells the story of what happened under each government and combines narrative with vignettes that range from the funding of a new treasury building to efforts to crowdsource ideas for spending cuts it also includes chapters devoted to different domains of spending control namely capital spending spending by subnational governments running cost expenditure fiscal forecasting and the development of new accounting metrics this book is based on over 120 in depth interviews of civil servants and ministers who were involved in public spending over the period as well as documents from the same timeframe it explores how and why despite much talk of change and reform in everything from parliamentary procedure to bureaucratic processes many of the underlying features of the uk s fiscal constitution persisted including arrangements for formula funding of the different countries within the union designed as a temporary stopgap in the transition to devolution to put uk developments into perspective the book includes a discussion of how the uk system was rated in reports from international bodies over the period which suggests that in such exercises the more political parts of the fiscal constitution were rated differently from the more technocratic parts given several volcanic type political eruptions in the uk over recent years the book concludes by exploring some different possible

scenarios for the future of its fiscal constitution in the light of those and other possible eruptions to come
